8. Rights of the data subject

- Right to **rectification** if the data are inaccurate or incomplete in accordance with article 16 GDPR
- Right to **erasure**, insofar as one of the conditions specified in article 17 GDPR applies
- Right to **restrict processing**, as long as one of the grounds laid out in article 18 GDPR applies
- Right to **object** to future processing of their personal data in accordance with article 21 GDPR
- Right to **lodge a complaint** with the **supervisory authority** in accordance with article 13 subsection 2 letter d) GDPR if the data subject believes their personal data has been unlawfully processed. The competent supervisory authority is:
